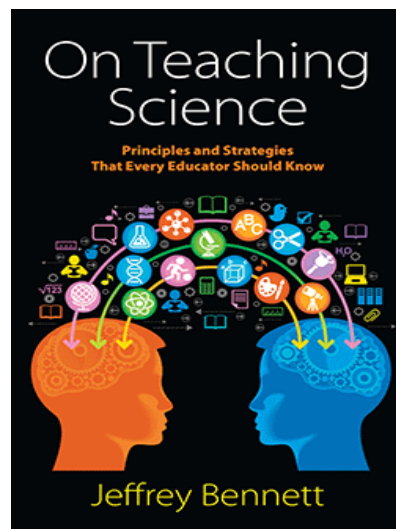


Strategies for Teaching Science
